Portrait and Figure Drawing

- ☆ Drawing board with clips to hold paper
- ☆ Box of extra soft vine charcoal (I recommend Grumbacher, next best is Winsor Newton, available at Art Things or American Art)
- ☆ Sandpaper pad for sharpening vine charcoal
- ☆ Chamois cloth (available at Track Auto)
- ☆ Large pad of Strathmore white charcoal paper (500 series) or several sheets of Lana Royal Wove (available at Art Things in West Annapolis)
- ☆ Figure class only – large pad of newsprint or other inexpensive paper for quick sketches, in addition to the paper listed above
- ☆ Kneaded rubber eraser
- ☆ No. 2, long handle, round bristle brush

Note: Some masonite drawing boards are smaller than the drawing paper. In that case, trim the bottom edge of the paper to fit the board. Alternatively, you may want to make your own drawing board using ¼" masonite, about 24" x 26", bull clips to hold paper available at Art Things or Office Depot.
